PARADE RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entrants must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow instructions from police and parade officials. The parade committee reserves the right to remove any entrant from the parade that is not abiding by the rules at any time during the parade.
2. The Kiddie parade will start the parade and children up to 16 years of age are welcome to participate. All other participants will be entered in the Adult portion of the parade. Please see the provided parade categories.
3. If your float or unit plans to distribute items { candy, toys, printed materials, buttons, etc.}, it MUST be done while on foot. Items MUST be HANDED to spectators, not tossed or thrown. Our intent is to keep all spectators safely on the sidewalks, and out of the path of oncoming parade units or vehicles. SAFETY FIRST!
4. Drivers of all vehicles in the parade must possess a valid drivers license, be at least 18 years of age, and possess all liability vehicle insurance.
5. All float participants must stay on the float and will not be allowed to jump on and off during the course of the parade. Participants will not have body parts, particularly legs and feet, extending past the sides, front, or rear of the float.
6. Please familiarize yourself with the parade categories for both of our parades. Paid performing units and marching bands are not eligible for prize money. Entries will be judged during parade line-up. Prize money for appropriate categories will be distributed by parade judges. All decisions by our judges are final.
7. Area dignitaries, queens, politicians and mayors, as well as promotional and informational units, are welcome to participate in our parade. No monetary compensation will be provided for these types of entrants. Please do not pass out decals or stickers, as we have had incidents of inappropriate usage and complaints from property owners about removal or damage caused by such items.
8. The Celebrate Aurora committee does not accept the responsibility for travel, food, or lodging expenses of any unit.
9. The Celebrate Aurora Committee, Inc. reserves the right to remove from the parade any participants who are obviously intoxicated, possess firearms, display offensive signs or materials, degrade any ethnic or religious group, or exhibit rude or discourteous conduct.
10. Applicant agrees to immediately clean up after any animals which are part of their performing unit.
